To these is added a group of topics on Alaska. The studies will serve as a guide to individual reading, but are especially designed for a club, and are arranged for fifteen meetings. A director should be chosen to assign topics to individual members, to modify the program to suit the peculiar conditions of the club, and to point out the relations between the topics. Every member of the club should prepare the subject for the evening in some general history. As a convenient popular guide Drake's Making of the Great West may be used, with the caution that it is not free from errors in matters of detail. The...
